

LEAP INTO SPRING WITH GULL DISCOUNT DAY

A Level 4 snap lockdown saw Gull's August Discount Day cancelled and so to thank Aucklanders and essential workers for keeping the City of Sails safe during these challenging and uncertain times Gull is offering Kiwi motorists a second 12 cent per litre Discount Day in the month of September.

The Spring Discount Day will apply to all Gull's fuel types across the company's entire network from 7:00am on Wednesday 29 September 2021 until 12:00pm midday on Thursday 30 September 2021.

Gull's Pricing Analyst Crystal Feist says Gull understands the pressure lockdowns can put on all households and wants to help alleviate some of that pain by lowering prices at the pumps for a second week in September. Gull would also like to remind motorists to respect Covid-19 restrictions in their respective areas - please be kind, wear a mask, scan, and socially distance whilst fueling up.

Gull's Discount Days are our way of giving back to New Zealand motorists and the loyal customers who continue to support us. As always, there is no minimum spend and no maximum fill restrictions and our price boards and pump prices are simply dropped from 7:00am today, for purchase of as much or as little fuel as you like.

At the majority of Gull outlets where Gull controls retail prices across the country, **average prices** will be as follows during the above-mentioned time frame:

Diesel	\$1.377

All pricing across the Gull network is GST inclusive.
