

GULL OFFERS RETURN FROM HOLIDAY DISCOUNT DESPITE RISING FUEL PRICES

2021 has seen fuel prices rise already as the cost of oil (per barrel) has increased over January. To welcome many people back from holiday, Gull is offering Kiwi motorists a welcome 10 cent per litre Discount Day, which will apply to all of Gull's fuel types across the company's entire network, from 7:00am on Thursday 28 January 2021 until 12:00pm midday on Friday 29 January 2021.

Gull's Pricing Analyst Crystal Feist says Gull wants to give back to Kiwis who have supported the Gull team throughout the past year of uncertainty.

"Gull's Discount Days are for everyone – no minimum spend and no maximum fill restrictions. Our price boards and pump prices are simply dropped from 7:00am today to purchase as little or as much fuel as you require, so you can get out and enjoy time with your family."
